Every year the Club receives complaints from landowners that ATV's/UTV's are using the snowmobile trail. This has resulted in a few landowners closing off their land and trails to us. Please respect our landowners and ride only on trails that you have permission to be on.

The club's Tucker Sno-Cat needs to have some body work done on the cab where it is starting to rust out.
